The smoke alarm at the above location:

**The Ontario Fire Code states that “no person shall intentionally disable a smoke alarm so as to make it inoperable”. A tenant or any other person who intentionally disables a smoke alarm (i.e. removing the battery or disconnecting the alarm) is guilty of a provincial offence and may be subject to a fine, imprisonment or both.**

I acknowledge that the smoke alarm was tested as indicated above and understand that it is my responsibility as the tenant to notify the building owner or his designate should the smoke alarm(s) require maintenance.
