STANTEC Consultants, who have been retained by the Town for this project, will be presenting a recommendation report with respect to this proposal at this meeting.

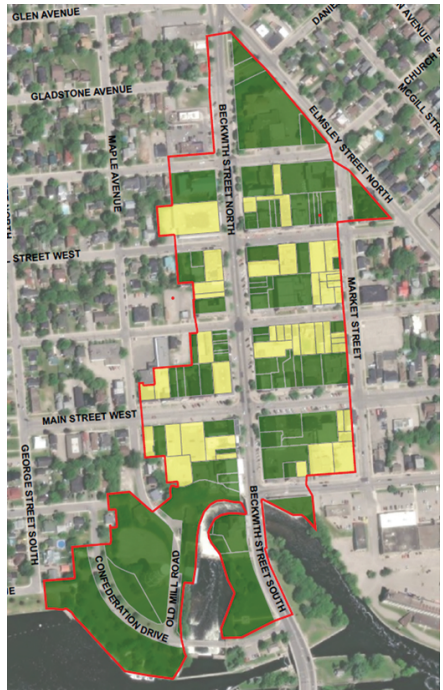


Figure 1. Downtown Smiths Falls
