 - a) Grant Update

Assuming elections are having a toll on getting grant funding or hearing back-Applied for the Victim Support Grant back in October and the money needs to be spent by end of March, still have not heard anything. NG911- It Support towards the grant, which took the budget like down. Overtime budget was knocked down to \$70,000- not ideal if we run into illness/ short staffing or major cases. Helped with the tax levy to get it down to 19%.

Nothing has been purchased yet but with the potential tariffs that could be comingcould really effect the automobile industry. The pressure is on now for cruiserslooking for the board's approval to increase the capital for the cruiser. This will not affect the other capital items as they came in under budget.
