# Smiths Falls Heritage House Museum



Located on the picturesque Rideau Canal waterway at Old Sly's Lock Station, the Smiths Falls Heritage House Museum functions as a community museum and historic house. It depicts the upper-middle-class life of the Bates Family circa 1865-1875 and features changing displays of Smiths Falls artifacts and history, travelling exhibits and art shows. A visit offers unique mirror-image facades, an indoor brick bake oven, period rooms, exhibition galleries and a famous two-story privy.
