





# ASSAULT POLICE / RESIST ARREST – JULY 2025

- IN THE MONTH OF JULY 2025 THERE WERE 3 ASSAULT POLICE CHARGES, AND 4 RESIST ARREST CHARGES ISSUED FROM VARIOUS OCCURRENCES
- SUSPICIOUS MALE DANCING IN MIDDLE OF INTERSECTION IN EARLY MORNING HOURS – APPEARED TO BE IN SOME TYPE OF PSYCHOSIS. OFFICERS ATTEMPT NUMEROUS DE-ESCALATION TACTICS TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO THE MALE. DURING THE INTERACTION THE MALE ATTACKS BOTH OFFICERS AND BEGINS PUNCHING AND KICKING THEM. TASER , PEPPER SPRAY AND BATON WERE GENERALLY INEFFECTIVE. SUBJECT EVENTUALLY ARRESTED AND IMMEDIATE MEDICAL AID WAS ADMINISTERED – SUBJECT DELIVERED KICK TO THE HEAD OF OFFICER WHO WAS TRYING TO PROVIDE FIRST AID
- OFFICER ATTEMPTING TO ARREST A WANTED FEMALE WHO WAS OBSERVED WALING ON THE STREET. OFFICER WAS ASSAULTED AND PUNCHED REPEATEDLY BY THE SUBJECT AND STRUGGLE ENSUED TO PLACE SUBJECT UNDER ARREST. EARRING RIPPED OUT OF OFFICERS' EAR DURING ASSAULT.
- POLICE CONDUCTING A WELFARE CHECK OF SUICIDAL INDIVIDUAL. SUBJECT SPRAYED A NOXIOUS SUBSTANCE DIRECTLY INTO FACE OF OFFICERS UPON ARRIVAL. DURING INTERACTION OFFICER STRUCK IN FACE WITH A JOLLY JUMPER SWING. SUBJECT ALSO SPAT DIRECTLY INTO FACE OF OFFICER AND MADE NUMEROUS THREATS TO CAUSE INJURY AND DEATH. SUBJECT APPREHENDED UNDER THE MENTAL HEALTH ACT AND TAKEN FOR ASSESSMENT. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT ALL OF THE ABOVE WAS CONDUCTED IN THE PRESENCE OF AN INFANT CHILD WHO OFFICERS WERE ATTEMPTING TO PROTECT AS WELL.
