SPLASH PAD RULES AND REGULATIONS

THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE FOR YOUR SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT

USE OF THIS SPLASH PAD IS AT YOUR OWN RISK

THIS AREA MAY BE CLOSED OR ITS USE LIMITED AT ANY TIME DUE TO WEATHER, OPERATIONAL DIFFICULTIES OR AT THE DISCRETION OF THE TOWN OF SMITHS FALLS

RULES

1. Splash pad hours are Sunday – Saturday
From 10 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.
2. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. Swim diapers are required for all non toilet trained children.
4. Appropriate swim attire (no cut off shorts) is required to enter splash pad area.
5. Swim shoes (no street shoes) are allowed in the splash pad area.
6. No strollers, lawn chairs, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, or other type of objects are permitted in the splash pad area.
7. No pets, glass, bottles, rocks, or other foreign objects are permitted in the splash pad area.
8. No athletic equipment or any type of toys are permitted in the splash pad area.
9. No climbing, hanging, swinging or pulling on any splash pad equipment is permitted. Do not put your eyes in direct contact with a geyser or water spray device and do not sit on geysers or drains.
10. Running and rough play is prohibited in the splash pad area.

HYGIENE SAFETY

1. No expulsion of bodily fluids (urine, feces, saliva, mucus or blood) is allowed in the Splash pad area.
2. Do not enter the splash pad area if you are ill (fever, diarrhea, vomiting) or have open sores.
3. Do not change or dispose of soiled diapers in the splash pad area.
4. Do not drink the splash pad water.

WARNINGS

1. Smoking, alcohol, drugs and improper behaviour are prohibited.
2. Exit splash pad immediately and seek cover upon the first sign of thunder, lightning or severe weather.
3. **In the event of emergency, call 911. Splash Pad address is Lower Reach Park (Jasper Ave. and Old Slys Road).**

5. Minimum 20 C. required to open facility.
