BY-LAW TO AMEND SCHEDULE A OF BY-LAW 7659-2001 BEING A BY-LAW TO
ESTABLISH A TRAFFIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS By-Law 7659-2001, a By-Law to Establish a Traffic Advisory Committee was passed on November 19, 2001;


AND WHEREAS Council has deemed it expedient to amend the Terms of Reference;

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls enacts as follows:


1. THAT Schedule A of By-Law 7659-2001 be rescinded and replaced with Schedule A of this by-law.
2. THAT By-law 8033-2007 be rescinded.
3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the final reading thereof.

Traffic Advisory Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose/Mandate

The purpose of the Smiths Falls Traffic Advisory Committee is to research matters related to the control and movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic within the Town of Smiths Falls when referred to them by the C.A.O., Directors or Police Chief.

Members

The Committee will be comprised of a minimum of three 3 citizen appointments made by Council.

Meetings

The Committee will meet as necessary or at minimum quarterly.

Term of Appointment

Members will be appointed to the Traffic Advisory Committee for the term prescribed in the appointing by-law or resolution.

First Meeting (Appointment of Chair and Secretary)

At the first meeting of each year the committee shall select a Chair and a Secretary.

Reports

The Committee will report their findings in writing to the C.A.O., Directors and Police Chief. Once reviewed, the C.A.O., Directors and Police Chief, will report and issues to Council that require a policy decision.

Liaison

The Chair of the Committee will report directly to the Director of Community Services.
