

Condition under which your fire would be extinguish by the Fire Department at owner expenses:

- b) Unattended fires
- c) Fire exceeding the outdoor fireplace size
- d) If the fire, in our judgement, creates a special hazard
- e) Grass, rubbish, leaves, etc. cannot be burnt with town's limits. Outdoor fireplace are for recreational fire only
- f) Failure to obtain a permit
