CALLS FOR SERVICE – FEBRUARY 2025

- FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY POLICE RESPONDED TO **573** CALLS FOR SERVICE.

- OVERALL THERE WERE 76 CRIMINAL CHARGES LAID – (**UP FROM 60 CHARGES FEBRUARY 2024)
- 30 ARRESTS MADE – (**UP FROM 20 IN FEBRUARY 2024)
- IPV CASES- 11 (DOWN FROM 19 IN JANUARY 2025)
- ASSAULTS- 11 (UP FROM 7 IN JANUARY 2025)
- FAMILY DISPUTES- 7 (DOWN FROM 13 IN JANUARY 2025)
- BAIL VIOLATIONS- 4
- SEXUAL ASSAULTS- 4 (UP FROM 2 IN JANUARY 2025)
- DRUG OFFENCES – 5 (UP FROM 1 IN JANUARY 2025)
- MISCHIEF – 7 (UP FROM 3 IN JANUARY 2025)

MENTAL HEALTH ACT INCIDENTS

- 22 CALLS FOR SERVICE, 2% APPREHENSION RATE WITH 2H AVERAGE WAIT TIME- HIGHEST BEING 3H 30M
- FEBRUARY SHOWED AN INCREASE IN MENTAL HEALTH ACT CALLS (UP FROM 12 IN JANUARY 2025)
- DECREASE IN APPREHENSION RATE (DOWN FROM 8%)

- CHARGES ISSUED RELATING TO SPEED, STOP SIGNS, TRAFFIC LIGHT INFRACTIONS, FAILING TO YIELD, DRIVE UNDER SUSPENSION, CARELESS DRIVING, HAND HELD DEVICE ETC.
- 9 CHARGES UNDER THE COMPULSORY AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE ACT ISSUED

CRIMINAL CHARGES VIA TRAFFIC STOPS - FEBRUARY

- 20 CRIMINAL CHARGES LAID RELATED TO TRAFFIC STOPS (**UP FROM 7 IN JANUARY 2025)
- IMPAIRED OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE
- EXCEED 80 MGS OF ALCOHOL IN BLOOD WHILE OPERATING MOTOR VEHICLE
- REFUSE TO PROVIDE BREATH SAMPLE
- FAIL TO COMPLY WITH RELEASE CONDITIONS
- DRIVE MOTOR VEHICLE WITH CANNABIS IN OPEN BAGGAGE
