<b>19.0</b>	<b>RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAY &amp; PARKING LOTS - SECURITY DEPOSIT</b> Determined by the Chief Building Official annually based on industry standards of costs per square metre of asphalt. Failure to complete hard surfacing of the driveway within one year of occupancy permit will result in forfeiture of this deposit to the Town. The Town will have the work done and all extra costs; including an administration fee based on five hours, will be billed to the owner and collected like taxes as outlined under the Municipal Act.	
<b>20.0</b>	<b>OTHER APPLICABLE FEES/SERVICES AND PERMITS NOT DESCRIBED HEREIN</b> Fees for classes of permits or services not described or included in this schedule shall be determined by the Chief Building Official and recorded in Schedule A-1. Said fees shall be based on the hourly charge.	
<b>REFUNDS</b>		
	Refund of fees shall be determined at the sole determination of the Chief Building Official and shall be a percentage of the fees payable under this by-law. The following shall be used as a guideline:  90 percent if administrative functions only have been performed 70 percent if administrative and zoning/law compliance functions/review have been performed 50 percent if administrative, zoning and plan examination functions have been performed 45 percent if permit issued/prepared and no field inspections have been performed subsequent to issuance  Additional hourly deduction per inspection performed Additional hourly deduction (or part thereof) for file review to determine refund and permit revocation approval.  No refund shall be issued if the balance does not cover the costs incurred by the Town on the file	

**Fees shall be annually increased by the consumer price index - Ottawa Region without amendment to this by-law or further public meetings.**
