



APPLICATION FOR THE SALE OF FIREWORKS

No person shall sell fireworks without a valid permit (must be renewed annually).

Fee: The fee for such permit is \$75 for the first year, \$50 subsequent year and \$25 if concurrent with business licensing process.

“Consumer Firework” means an outdoor, low hazard, recreational firework that is classed as a subdivision 1 of Division 2 of Class 7 Fireworks under the Act and includes fireworks showers, fountains, golden rain, lawn lights, pin wheels, Roman candles, and volcanoes, but does not include sparklers, Christmas crackers, and caps for toy guns containing not in excess of twenty-five one-hundredths of a grain of explosive used percap.

“Display Firework” means an outdoor, high hazard, recreational firework that is classed as a subdivision 2 of Division 2 of Class 7 Fireworks under the Act, and includes rockets, serpents, shells, bombshells, tourbillions, maroons, large wheels, bouquets, bombardos, waterfalls, fountains, batteries, illumination, set pieces and pigeons but does not include firecrackers;

“Firecracker” means a pyrotechnic device that explodes when ignited and does not make any subsequent display or visible effect after the explosion, and includes those devices commonly known as Chinese firecrackers. **No person shall sell any firecrackers with the Town of Smiths Falls.**

“Pyrotechnic Special Effect Firework” means a high hazard firework that is classed as a subdivision 5 of Division 2 of Class 7 Firework under the Act and that is used to produce a special pyrotechnic effect for indoor or outdoor performances and includes black powder bombs, bullet effect, flash powder, air bursts, smoke compositions, gerbs, lances and wheels; and

“Prohibited Firework” includes but is not limited to cigarette loads or plugs, exploding matches, sparkling matches, ammunition for miniature tie clip, cufflink or key chain pistols, auto alarms or jokers, cherry bombs, M-80 and silver salutes and flash crackers, throw down torpedoes and cracking balls, exploding golf balls, stink bombs and smoke bombs, tear gas pens and launchers, party poppers and table bombs, table rockets and bottle sky rockets, fake firecrackers and other trick devices or practical jokes as included on the most recent list of prohibited fireworks as published from time to time under the Act. **No person shall sell any prohibited fireworks within the Town of Smiths Falls.**
