

MAJOR INCIDENT

- JUNE 04TH 2025 - CRIMINAL CODE SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTED AT A MAIN STREET WEST APARTMENT
- INFORMATION HAD BEEN RECEIVED REGARDING AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS IN POSSESSION OF AN UNAUTHORIZED FIREARM AND AMMUNITION AT THEIR RESIDENCE
- SEVERAL S.F.P.S. MEMBERS ASSISTED WITH THE SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTION INCLUDING SURVEILLANCE, ARREST, IDENT AND SCENE PROCESSING
- ACCUSED WAS ARRESTED WITHOUT INCIDENT AS THEY LEFT THE APARTMENT ON FOOT
- ALSO SEIZED – TASER, SPRING LOADED EDGED WEAPON, VARIOUS RIFLE AND SHOTGUN ROUNDS
- NUMEROUS CHARGES RELATED TO FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION ISSUED



ASSAULT POLICE / RESIST ARREST – JUNE 2025

- IN THE MONTH OF JUNE 2025 THERE HAVE BEEN 8 ASSAULT POLICE CHARGES, AND 2 RESIST ARREST CHARGES ISSUED FROM VARIOUS OCCURRENCES
- TRESPASS TO PROPERTY COMPLAINT – OFFICERS ARRIVED, MALE UNCOOPERATIVE, COMBATIVE AND IN DRUG INDUCED CRISIS– PEPPER SPRAY WAS INEFFECTIVE – MULTIPLE TASER DEPLOYMENTS – OFFICERS WERE PUNCHED AND KNEED IN THE FACE AND KICKED IN THE KNEECAP DURING ARREST
- MISCHIEF CALL – TEENAGER OUT OF CONTROL DESTROYING THE FAMILY HOUSE – OFFICERS ARRIVED AND ATTEMPTED TO DE-ESCALATE SUBJECT WHO REMAINED COMBATIVE- OFFICER KICKED IN THE CHEST AND GENITALS BEFORE ARREST COULD BE COMPLETED
- BELLIGERENT CUSTOMER AT LOCAL RESTAURANT – OFFICERS ARRIVED AND DURING EXECUTION OF ARREST WERE KICKED AND SPIT UPON REPEATEDLY
- WHILE REMOVING SUBJECT FROM CELLS INTO CUSTODY OF PRISONER TRANSPORT UNIT OFFICERS WERE SPIT ON AND HAD URINE-SOAKED TOILET PAPER THROWN ON THEM
