# CALLS FOR SERVICE – JANUARY 2025

# NOTEWORTHY CALLS FOR SERVICE – JANUARY

- OVERALL THERE WERE 72 CRIMINAL CHARGES LAID (29 ARRESTS MADE – UP FROM 26 IN DECEMBER 2024)
- IPV CASES- 19 (UP FROM 12 IN DECEMBER 2024)
- ASSAULTS- 7
- FAMILY DISPUTES- 13 (UP FROM 7 IN DECEMBER 2024)
- BAIL VIOLATIONS- 7
- SEXUAL ASSAULTS- 2
- DRUG OFFENCES – 1
- MISCHIEF – 3 (DOWN FROM 8 IN DECEMBER 2024)

# MENTAL HEALTH ACT INCIDENTS

- 12 CALLS FOR SERVICE, 8% APPREHENSION RATE WITH 1H 06M AVERAGE WAIT TIME- HIGHEST BEING 1H 50M
- DECEMBER SHOWED A DECREASE IN IN MENTAL HEALTH ACT CALLS (DOWN FROM 43)
- DECREASE IN APPREHENSION RATE (DOWN FROM 19%)
- DECREASE IN WAIT TIMES (DOWN FROM 3H 16M)

# TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT/COMPLAINTS

- THE S.T.E.P. TARGET FOR FEBRUARY 2025 WILL BE WINTER DRIVING SAFETY – FOLLOWING TOO CLOSE, EXCESSIVE SPEED AND OBSTRUCTED VIEW (WINDSHIELD)
