

Requirements for CIP Incentive Program

Program 6: Affordable Housing and Universal Accessibility Co-Application

Program Summary

This program allows the support of Program 3, 4, 5 for affordable housing to be stacked with the supports of Program 1 and/or 2 for universal accessibility.

Available Funding

Eligible applicants who qualify for Program 3, 4, and 5 AND Program 1 and/or Program 2 can qualify to receive a rebate under Program 6. Available funding is dependent on the amount of funding an applicant is eligible to receive under each qualifying program. Please see program specific information sheets for more information on available funding.

Criteria to Meet

Property owners may be eligible for funding under this program if they create at least one affordable housing unit in accordance with Program 3, 4, and 5 and provide exterior and/or interior universally accessible features in accordance with Program 1 and/or Program 2.

For Program 3 (Affordable Housing Building Permit Fee and Planning Application Fee Rebate):

- Program 3 and Program 1;
- Program 3 and Program 2; or
- Program 3 and Program 1 and Program 2.

For Program 5 (Affordable Housing Additional Residential Unit Rebate):

- Program 5 and Program 1;
- Program 5 and Program 2; or
- Program 5 and Program 1 and Program 2.

Note: If an applicant qualifies for more than one of the affordable housing Programs (Program 3, 4, and 5) and also meets the criteria for Program(s) 1 and/or 2, the applicant will receive funding for Program(s) 1 and/or 2 only once.
