

- THE S.T.E.P. TARGET FOR OCTOBER 2025 WILL BE SEATBELT OFFENCES
- TOP TRAFFIC ENFORCERS IN AUGUST WERE CONSTABLES ROBIDOUX/ B. KEOGAN / SLY






CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE BRANCH/CISO- SEPTEMBER

- LEAD INVESTIGATOR ON MISSING PERSON FILE (BERTRIM) – ASSISTING CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS BRANCH (O.P.P.)
- CHILD LURING CASE - SEARCH WARRANT FOR PHONE RECORDS COMPLETED – SUSPECT LURED A 15-YEAR-OLD PERSON FROM RESIDENCE TO MEET UP – VICTIM WAS LATER ASSAULTED
- ROBBERY FROM LOCAL CONVENIENCE STORE – INVESTIGATION ONGOING
- DNA WARRANT RESULTS IN FURTHER CHARGES BEING ISSUED TO SUSPECT IN SEXUAL ASSAULT INVESTIGATION INVOLVING CHILD UNDER 16 YEARS
- SUBSTANTIAL FRAUD CASE ONGOING – WORKING WITH DURHAM REGIONAL POLICE TO MOVE THE INVESTIGATION FORWARD
- ROMANCE SCAM INVESTIGATION – VICTIM HAS BEEN DEFRAUDED OF OVER \$10,000. INVESTIGATION ONGOING TO IDENTIFY A SUSPECT.
- SEXUAL ASSAULT INVESTIGATION – COLLABORATION WITH CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES AND OTHER SUPPORT AGENCIES.
- SIGNIFICANT FRAUD OF LOCAL BUSINESS – WORKING WITH CALGARY POLICE SERVICE FRAUD UNIT AS THEY ARE INVESTIGATING SIMILAR TYPE FRAUD WITH LINKED SUSPECTS.
- DETECTIVE DROESKE COMPLETED THE 2-WEEK CRISIS NEGOTIATOR COURSE IN KINGSTON, ONTARIO – WILL JOIN SERGEANT KING AS OUR SECOND TRAINED NEGOTIATOR AS PER THE C.S.P.A. REQUIREMENTS.


