DROP-IN SKATE RULES

**Drop-in skating sessions are family-friendly.
Intended for casual, recreational skating only.**

- 1. CSA approved helmets are recommended for all ages. Helmets are mandatory for all Shinny, Stick & Puck, and school programming.**
- 2. Skate in the posted direction. Direction may change during the session.**
- 3. No speed skating, racing, weaving through skaters or reverse skating.**
- 4. No horseplay, chasing or throwing ice/snow.**
- 5. Skaters must wear skates while on the ice. No shoes/boots permitted.**
- 6. No strollers, sleds, wheelchairs or other aids unless expressly permitted.**
- 7. Children 11 and under must be directly supervised by a parent or guardian inside the facility.**
- 8. No food, drink or handheld devices on the ice surface.**
- 9. Full hockey gear must be worn for Shinny; helmets and gloves are required for all Stick & Puck sessions.**
- 10. Follow all staff directions. Unsafe actions may result in removal.**
